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Tournament of Minds 2017

On Saturday 2 September four teams of year 5 and 6 children competed at Albany Junior High School for the Tournament of Minds Regional Shield. Tournament of Minds is a problem solving programme where students have to work together to solve a demanding, open ended long term challenges over a six week period without any outside assistance. They have ten minutes to present their solution to a panel of judges and audience on the Tournament Day. Two of our teams selected the Social Sciences Challenge, one team the Language Literature Challenge while the other team opted for the Engineering Maths Challenge - a first for our school. The challenges tested their ability to work together, their problem solving skills, creativity and presentation skills. While preparing for their Long Term challenge the children were also practicing their teamwork skills for a four minute 'unseen' Spontaneous Challenge on Tournament Day. During this challenge they were awarded points for their ability to answer the question, creativity of their answers as well as their teamwork skills.

On the day nerves were high and it was lovely to see all four teams supporting each other in their presentations. In all teams the children were highly organised and had made innovative costumes and props. The presentations from all schools were of a very high calibre and the competition was rife. It was fantastic to see such very talented performers.

At the end of a long day it was time for prizegiving and the results we had all been waiting for. All four teams should be commended for their hard work and commitment over the past 6 weeks. Their behaviour and team spirit on the day was impeccable and they should all be very proud of what they achieved.

YEAR TWO, THREE AND FOUR SPRING NETBALL

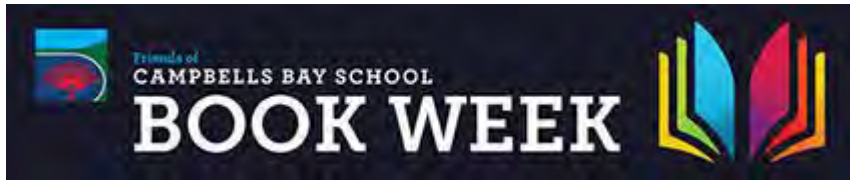

He lives on Waiheke Island with his wife Rowan Sommerset and son Linden. Over the years he has worn many hats including milk boy, barman, singer/songwriter, music consultant and copywriter. He was born in Christchurch and attended Westlake Boys High School in Auckland, and graduated with a Bachelor of Management Studies from Waikato University.
