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## 2016 CBS Cross Country winners doing well on the track:

Four of our students who won the CBS cross country for their year groups last year went on to join Takapuna Athletics Club and compete on the track over the summer.

Last year's year five winner, Josh Ford, and year six winner Cameron Maunder, competed in the middle distance events at the Auckland Athletics Champs. Both boys ran exceptionally well and finished on the podium for their respective events, running personal best times in some of their events. Josh Ford finished second in the 10 year old boys 1500m and 800m and finished third in the 10 year old boys 400m. Cameron Maunder finished second in the 11 year old boys 1500m and won gold in the 11 year old boys 800m. Both Josh and Cameron competed at the Auckland Junior Champs on Saturday in the 2000m track event. Both Cameron and Josh ran a well timed and strong race to take the gold medal and to finish the athletics season as Auckland Champions for their age groups.



Congratulations to Travis Findlay, our year four cross country winner from last year, for winning gold in the 9 year old boys 400m on Saturday. Our year two cross country winner, Caleb Maunder, placed fifth in the 7 year old boys discus and made it through to the final for the 7 year old boys 200m.
