Bus Bay Morning and Afternoon



With the 042 bus broken down in the bus bay after school the usual efficient flow of vehicles was brought to pretty much a grinding halt until we could exit the bus. The 042 bus usually departs the bus bay by 3.10pm.

If you see the bus in the bus bay after this time there is probably a problem. It doesn't happen often but it is not unknown. If the bus is still in the bus bay after 3.10pm please follow the instructions of a member of our staff who will be attired in a bright vest and will be doing their level best to ensure some sort of order is maintained. Thanks.

Mornings

In the mornings I am usually in the bus bay from about 8.30am onwards and if I am not present there is usually some more than adequate replacement 😊

The purpose of our presence is to ensure a flow of vehicles and to meet and greet not only those alighting from vehicles but also those arriving on foot or on scooters and bikes.

This is by no means a fool-proof system. We cannot guarantee every child will be greeted and taken across the bus bay to the footpath. If you are in the road side lane in the bus bay and I or another member of staff are not readily at hand (but are present) it is fine to have your child wait on the grass and we will escort your child across the lanes to the footpath.

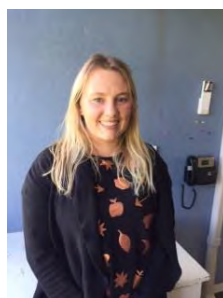

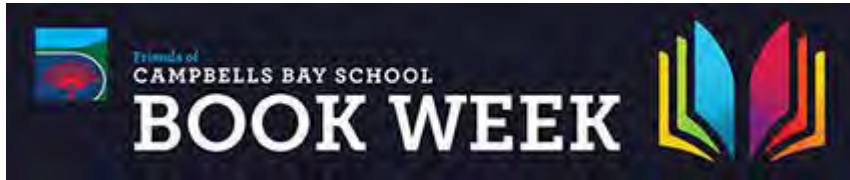

Angel Star is illustrated by another fabulous guest we'll have at Book Week, Kat Merewether.

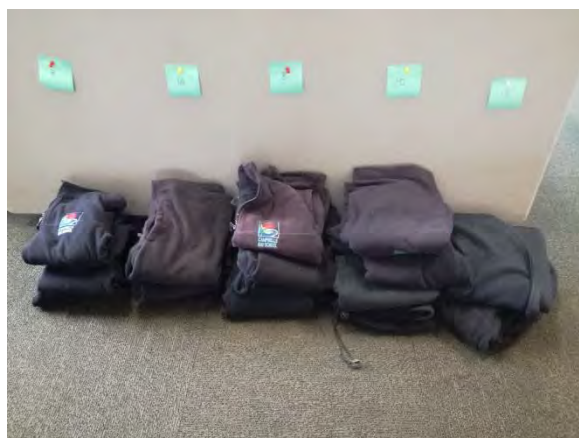

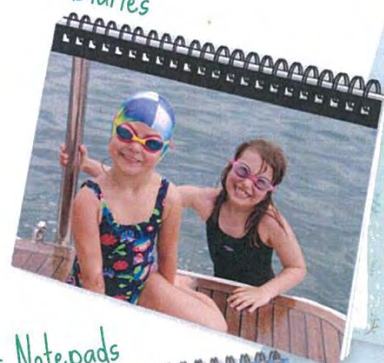

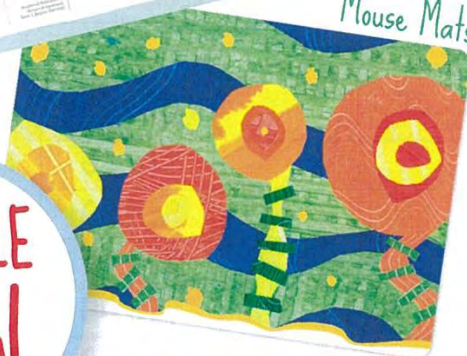

Watanabes' story - Before NZ

This is a story about our journey from nowhere to somewhere. Hello, we are Watanabes. We are a family of five, Makiko (my wife), Satsuki (Year 6), Riku (Year 4), Kanjiro (Year 1) and me, Kotaro. Makiko and I are originally from Japan. As a child Makiko travelled a lot following her father. In contrast, I was very much domestic growing up in a suburban city near Tokyo. I had never been out of Japan until I was 21 when Makiko and her friends took me to India. My trip to India was literally an eye-opener which made me realise "there is the world, there really is". This trip turned my eyes from inward to outward. After working for three years in Japan, Makiko and I went over to London where I studied for one year. We went back to Japan in 2003 and then in 2004 we moved to Singapore to open a new chapter of our life.

The three of our children were all born in Singapore. They were growing up healthily (there were some hiccups though) and we were enjoying our life in Singapore especially local foods. We had everything we needed and there were no major problems. However, one question began arising. "Will we remain in this country and see our children spend their childhood here? There might be a country which better suits our lifestyle.". Of course Singapore is a good country to live but we needed more nature or wilderness in our life. We wanted our children to more experience and appreciate the great nature rather than hanging around between those skyscrapers. Satsuki was about to finish her first year at a primary school so this might be the right timing and last chance for us to make a big change.

We started looking for our next destination and Google search gave us a list of candidate countries. New Zealand was on the top of the list. We had a look at photos of New Zealand and read blogs written by Japanese people who migrated to the country. All of them wrote about their new lives in New Zealand quite positively (beautiful nature, good schools and nice people). With great stories and great photos there were no reasons for us to shelve the idea of migrating to New Zealand. That was September 2013. As we heard the school term begins at the end of January or the beginning of February, we thought we'd better arrive before the new term starts. We only had two months left for the preparation. During the period we were extremely busy closing down our Singapore life coupled with lots of farewells. We made all the arrangements in such a rush that, for our New Zealand stay, we could only manage to arrange accommodation for the first few days and an old Toyota for us to get around. We landed in Auckland airport at around midnight on 25th of January, 2014 with three suitcases, a few travel bags and a saucepan. When we were still in Singapore, we learnt that New Zealand was imposing tight restrictions on imported goods especially foods and natural materials for the environmental reasons. So we were a little bit nervous at the luggage check point at the airport despite the fact that we were not bringing anything which would be thought to be illegal. After the officers checked all our belongings accordingly, they smiled at us and said "You have three children so you'd better go quickly." They were very kind after all. We arrived at the B&B at well past 2.00am and slept like a log. We were all exhausted from the long travel which took more than 20 hours door-to-door. We slept and slept until 1.00pm and woke up to the clearest, bluest and the most beautiful sky we had ever seen.
