- Select the number of students you want to make bookings for, and fill in their names.
- Press the blue "Go" button to go on to the next page.
- Choose a teacher.
- Select a year from the first box, then select a teacher from the second box.
- Press the green "Go" button to go on to the next page.
- Choose the time(s) you want.
- Press the blue "Go" button to go on to the next page.

You should leave time to get from one booking to the next if booking with more than one teacher. You can only select one timeslot per teacher. Each interview is 12 minutes long, with a bell at 15 minutes for the next interview to start.

The smooth running of our interview evening relies on all parents keeping to the timetable. Please consider other parents and end the interview on time. If you need more time with a particular teacher, please arrange a separate meeting or phone call.

Entries will be scored on the proficiency of the coding and game creativity.

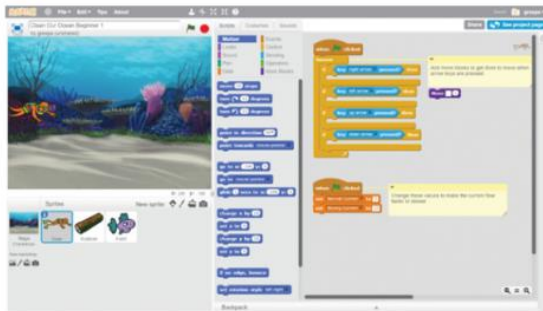
Each category winner will receive a Ranger Drone with HD camera for their classroom.
