It was a very close call between jackets **A** (the warm, dry and light style RRP \$55) and **B** (the 3K softshell style RRP \$89).

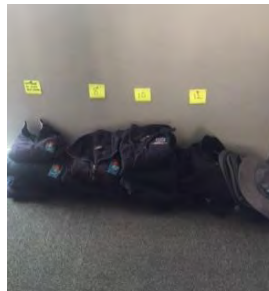

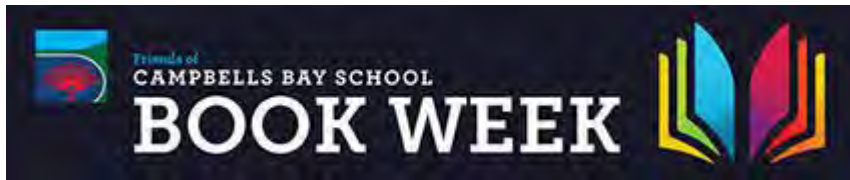
