Absences

Completing the school absences is a twice daily Ministry of Education requirement and given the size of school can take a considerable time to complete. We aim to complete the absences in a timely manner but would greatly appreciate your assistance with our process below to reduce the time taken and the number of messages sent from the school on a daily basis.

WHY INFORMING THE SCHOOL IS IMPORTANT

The most important reason is for the safety of your child, the greatest concern for the school is not knowing if your child is at home or whether something untoward has happened on the way to school. We cannot and do not assume your child is sick, at an appointment or away on holiday.

Therefore we ask you to **please** help us by informing the school office every day (not your child's teacher) **before 9.00am** if your child is going to be absent from school or arriving late for any reason (e.g. doctors, dentist or visits to other schools).

If your child is late to school they must report to the school office to obtain a late slip.

There are three ways you can contact us:

2. Use the Flexibuzz App
3. Call 410 9551 and leave a message on the answerphone.

If we are unable to establish the whereabouts of your child we will send you a text message or email. We would appreciate a reply to these messages. If we do not get a reply your child will be marked as truant.

What do broken yellow lines mean?

A BROKEN YELLOW LINE MEANS NO STOPPING OR PARKING.

Broken yellow lines are placed in areas where parking would cause an obstruction or danger to pedestrians, road users, and around bus stops, taxi stands, motorcycle parking and loading zones.

The broken yellow lines on Aberdeen Road are there to help keep our children safe by providing the best possible sight lines for pedestrians using the crossing. By parking on broken yellow lines (even for 'a minute') you are placing your convenience ahead of the safety of others. Please respect the law and the reason for it.

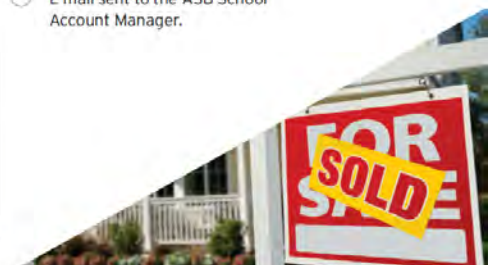

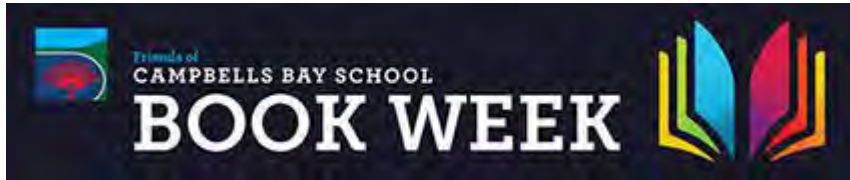
